Mr. Tyner is currently Executive Vice Chair of the Communist Party USA (CPUSA) and is a member of the national coordinating committee of the Black Radical Congress.

He ran for Vice President of the USA in 1972 and 1976 with Gus Hall on the CPUSA ticket. Raised in Philadelphia, he was a member of the Amalgamated Lithographers and Teamsters Union there. He has authored numerous articles and pamphlets on issues of civil rights, peace and working class struggles.
